

This Refuse Tag will indicate to City Refuse Collectors that the deceased body has been placed at curb side for collection by the City of Grand Rapids. The city reserves the right to change refuse rates and refund this tag at the original purchase price.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- 1.) Remains must be entirely human. Animals, animal/human hybrids, genetically-altered/vat-grown abominations, and household yard waste will not be accepted. Bodies stuffed post-mortem with household or yard waste will not be accepted.
- 2.) Corpses placed for curbside pickup should be clothed or wrapped in paper or plastic to prevent undue indecency.
- 3.) Corpses with mechanical attachments such as chainsaw or weapon limbs will not be accepted. Attachments must be removed or dismantled and deactivated prior to disposal.
- 4.) Burial items such as caskets and floral arrangements must be disposed of separately in a City Refuse Container, or with the proper Bulk or Refuse Collection tags.
- 5.) Personal items, clothing, or any other items carried on the corpse will be disposed of and cannot be retrieved. Please take care to retrieve any personal or useful items from the corpse prior to placing it for curbside pickup.
- 6.) Sectioned, ground, or liquefied humans shall be bagged or bound with a Bulk Body Parts Tag, or placed in a City Refuse Container. All wounds should be sealed or tied before disposal. Any body parts outside a City Refuse Container must be properly bagged or tied. Any leakage, seepage, spilling, or scattering is the responsibility of the homeowner.
- 7.) Corpses over 325lb shall have a City Bulk Human Corpse Collection Sticker attached, and be placed for curbside pickup.
- 8.) Corpses impaled on boards, pipes, or other objects over 3 feet in length shall be bundled securely with wire, and shall have a City Corpse Collection Tag attached to each bundle.
- 9.) No living or reanimated corpses will be accepted by the City of Grand Rapids. All corpses must be completely free of independent motion and self-sustainability, including consciousness, life, undead, zombification, cursed limbs or organs, reanimation spells, vampirification, electrically-assisted human reanimation, or brain transfer. Cursed limbs and organs that will not die should be brought to a local Possessed Waste Disposal Site for proper treatment and disposal.
